To be eligible, an applicant shall:

- Be a person residing in Malta; or
- An undertaking established in Malta¹, in which case state aid regulations shall apply; and
- Be the registered owner of a motor vehicle which has been retrofitted with an LPG Feeding System which:
 - i. For a **petrol-powered vehicle** complies with the requirements of UN ECE 67 or UN ECE 115 and has been approved by an approving authority as the kind authorized in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2018/858, and that allows the vehicle to operate using petrol or LPG; OR
 - ii. For a **diesel-powered vehicle** is approved by a type-approval authority of any Member State of the EU for use on the category of the vehicle concerned allowing the vehicle's engine to operate with diesel and LPG simultaneously with both fuels being metered separately and had its smoke emission value reduced by at least twenty five percent (25%) because of the retrofitting of the LPG feeding system.

Transport Malta reserves the right to carry out any necessary checks and actions based on the information provided in this form to confirm compliance with all relevant regulations.

Where a fraudulent claim arises, Transport Malta may institute criminal proceedings against those responsible. In the event of an incorrect payment of a claim, Transport Malta reserves the right to recover funds paid in error.

Filling your application DOES NOT automatically entitle you to receive the grant.

GRANT DETAILS

Subject to the scheme conditions, the following grant amounts shall be paid:

- €400 - Category M1 or N1 petrol vehicle retrofitted to operate on LPG or petrol;
- €900 - Category M1 or N1 diesel vehicle retrofitted to operate with LPG and diesel simultaneously;
- €1,000 - Category M2 or N2 diesel vehicle retrofitted to operate with LPG and diesel simultaneously;
- €1,500 - Category M3 or N3 diesel vehicle retrofitted to operate with LPG and diesel simultaneously.

Applicants are entitled for a maximum of 10 grants under this scheme.

In the case of a diesel-powered vehicle, I confirm that the retrofitted LPG feeding system is approved by a type-approval authority of an EU Member State for use on the category of the vehicle concerned, allows the vehicle's engine to operate with diesel and LPG simultaneously with both fuels being metered separately, has a visible meter allowing Transport Malta officers, or their delegates, to confirm that the vehicle is being regularly run using gaseous fuel, and that the smoke emission value of the vehicle were reduced by at least twenty five percent (25%).

I confirm that I have carried out checks, after retrofitting, to ensure that within the limits of the measuring method, emissions when running on the original fuel only have not deteriorated, and that emissions when LPG is added to the original fuel are less than those when the engine runs on the original fuel only.

I understand that giving false or misleading information in connection with this application is a serious offence and that Government officials may inspect any records. I undertake to keep relevant records applicable to this conversion to enable the Government to verify applications under the LPG feeding system vehicle grant scheme.

Data Protection Privacy Notice

The Authority for Transport in Malta (Transport Malta) of Triq Pantar, Lija, Malta, LJA 2021 is the Data Controller for the purpose of the Data Protection Act CAP 586 and the General Data Protection Regulation (EU) (GDPR) 2016/679. 1. The information we collect and how we use it

- 1.1. From this Application Transport Malta collects different types of information which information is that required by Law and is used explicitly for your applications. It is to be noted that if the required information is not provided the said application could not be processed.
- 1.2. The primary purpose for collecting information is mainly to process the applications related to granting of financial incentives, however, your Personal information may also be used for related purposes that amongst other include: sending notifications, requesting additional information, and for the provision of information with regards to any legislative amendments which may affect the services offered to you.

2. To whom we disclose information

- 2.1. This information will be solely used for the reasons detailed above. However, there may be cases where personal information is shared with the following third parties for reasons listed below;

 - Any third party concerned with this provision, management and control of such financial incentives, including auditors reviewing the internal process of the Authority or any other government department, entity, body or agency involved in the provision, management or control of financial incentives.

3. Data Subject Rights

- 3.1. With respect to your privacy rights, Transport Malta is obliged to provide you with reasonable access to the Personal Data that you have provided to us. Your other principal rights under data protection law are:

 - c. the right to rectification;
 - d. the right to erasure;

- 3.2. We will acknowledge your request within seventy-two (72) hours and will do our utmost to handle it promptly. We will respond to these requests within a month, with a possibility to extend this period for particularly complex requests in accordance with Applicable Law.

- 3.3. At any time, you may object to the processing of your Personal Data, on legitimate grounds, except if otherwise permitted by applicable law.

- 3.4. In accordance with Applicable Law, we reserve the right to withhold personal data if disclosing it would adversely affect the rights and freedoms of others. Moreover, we reserve the right to charge a fee for complying with such requests if they are deemed manifestly unfounded or excessive.

4. Retention period

- 4.1. Personal data will be retained for not more than 12 months from date of application should the application not be submitted complete or is rejected.
- 4.2. Once the grant is issued, we will retain your information for as long as needed to provide you with our service, or to comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes and enforce our agreements.

5. Security

- 5.1. We take appropriate security measures to protect against loss, misuse and unauthorized access, alteration, disclosure, or destruction of your information. Additionally, steps will also be taken to ensure the ongoing confidentiality, integrity, availability, and resilience of systems and services processing personal information, and will restore the availability and access to information in a timely manner in the event of a physical or technical incident. All information gathered is kept confidential and is used solely for the processing of applications for financial incentives.
