* Vehicle must have been continuously registered in Gozo between the 11th October 2021 and the date of scrappage, and the bank account to which the applicant requests the issue of the grant is registered on an address in Gozo.

NOTE1: Deregistered vehicles which had benefitted from the provisions of S.L.65.24 shall not be eligible for this scrappage scheme.

NOTE2: The vehicle to be scrapped must be registered on the applicant's name on the date of registration of the used Electric Vehicle unless it is scrapped and deregistered before such date.

NOTE 3: Applications for scrappage scheme submitted without the destruction certificate for the scrapped vehicle will be disregarded and the final grant amount will be calculated without the scrappage grant.

NOTE 4: For this scheme, a Used Electric Vehicle is defined as an electric vehicle originating from any of the following countries, and which was put into free circulation in such country before its entry into Malta:

- (a) any Member State of the European Union;
- (b) the United Kingdom;
- (c) the Channel Islands (Guernsey and Jersey);
- (d) the Isle of Man;
- (e) Monaco;
- (f) Andorra;
- (g) San Marino; or
- (h) Northern Ireland.

Data Protection Privacy Notice

The Authority for Transport in Malta (Transport Malta) of Triq Pantar, Lija, Malta, LJA 2021 is the Data Controller for the purpose of the Data Protection Act CAP 586 and the General Data Protection Regulation (EU) (GDPR) 2016/679. 1. The information we collect and how we use it

- 1.1. From this Application Transport Malta collects different types of information which information is that required by Law and is used explicitly for your applications. It is to be noted that if the required information is not provided the said application could not be processed.
- 1.2. The primary purpose for collecting information is mainly to process the applications related to granting of financial incentives, however, your Personal information may also be used for related purposes that amongst other include: sending notifications, requesting additional information, and for the provision of information with regards to any legislative amendments which may affect the services offered to you.

2. To whom we disclose information

3. Data Subject Rights

We will respond to these requests within a month, with a possibility to extend this period for particularly complex requests in accordance with Applicable Law.
 - 3.3. At any time, you may object to the processing of your Personal Data, on legitimate grounds, except if otherwise permitted by applicable law.
 - 3.4. In accordance with Applicable Law, we reserve the right to withhold personal data if disclosing it would adversely affect the rights and freedoms of others. Moreover, we reserve the right to charge a fee for complying with such requests if they are deemed manifestly unfounded or excessive.
- ### 4. Retention period
- 4.1. Personal data will be retained for not more than 12 months from date of application should the application not be submitted complete or is rejected.
 - 4.2. Once the grant is issued, we will retain your information for as long as needed to provide you with our service, or to comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes and enforce our agreements.

5. Security

- 5.1. We take appropriate security measures to protect against loss, misuse and unauthorized access, alteration, disclosure, or destruction of your information. Additionally, steps will also be taken to ensure the ongoing confidentiality, integrity, availability, and resilience of systems and services processing personal information, and will restore the availability and access to information in a timely manner in the event of a physical or technical incident. All information gathered is kept confidential and is used solely for the processing of applications for financial incentives.
- 5.2. If we learn of a security systems breach, we will inform you of the occurrence of the breach in accordance with applicable law.
