Removal of Vessels and Moorings off Malta Freeport Terminal 1 West at il- Bajja ta' Birzebbuga

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies mariners and owners of vessels, that due to large vessels berthing at Malta Freeport Terminal 1 West a new maneuvering area is being established.

Consequently, all vessels and moorings within the area A, B, C, D, and the intermediate coastline, as shown in red on the attached chart, are to be removed before Friday 14th March 2025 and the area is to remain clear from any vessel and mooring after this date.

Any vessels and moorings that are left in the above-mentioned area after the Friday 14th March 2025, will be removed at the expense of their owner. No liability whatsoever will be accepted by the Authority for any damage that may be caused while removing the said vessels.

Furthermore, mariners are reminded that it is prohibited to lay any moorings and ground tackle without the prior permission of the Authority and that approaches to marine terminals maneuvering areas and fairways are to be kept clear at all times. Failure to comply with the above directions may be subject to legal proceedings.
