Shifting of pontoon from Il-Port ta' L-Imġarr to Il-Port ta' Marsamxett

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies mariners and the general public that the temporary pontoon established by Local Notice to Mariners number 023 of 2020 will be shifted, at some time, between Monday 12th April 2021 and Saturday 17th April 2021.

The temporary pontoon will be shifted from its current position along the main breakwater at Il-Port ta' L-Imġarr, Gozo to Il-Port ta' Marsamxett.

In Il-Port ta' Marsamxett the pontoon will be permanently laid in three (3) sections within the area A, B, C, D, E and the intermediate coastline, as shown on attached chart.



All moorings and moored vessels within the above area are to be removed with immediate effect.

Mariners are to keep a sharp lookout, navigate with caution, and at very slow speed giving the indicated areas a wide berth. They are to comply with any instructions given by Valletta Port Control (Valletta VTS) on VHF Channel 12 and/or 16 and any Enforcement Personnel on site.
