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Rhodolith Survey within Maltese Territorial Waters

The Ports and Yachting Directorate of Transport Malta would like to inform mariners and owners of vessels that a Rhodolith Survey will be conducted within the Maltese Territorial Waters.

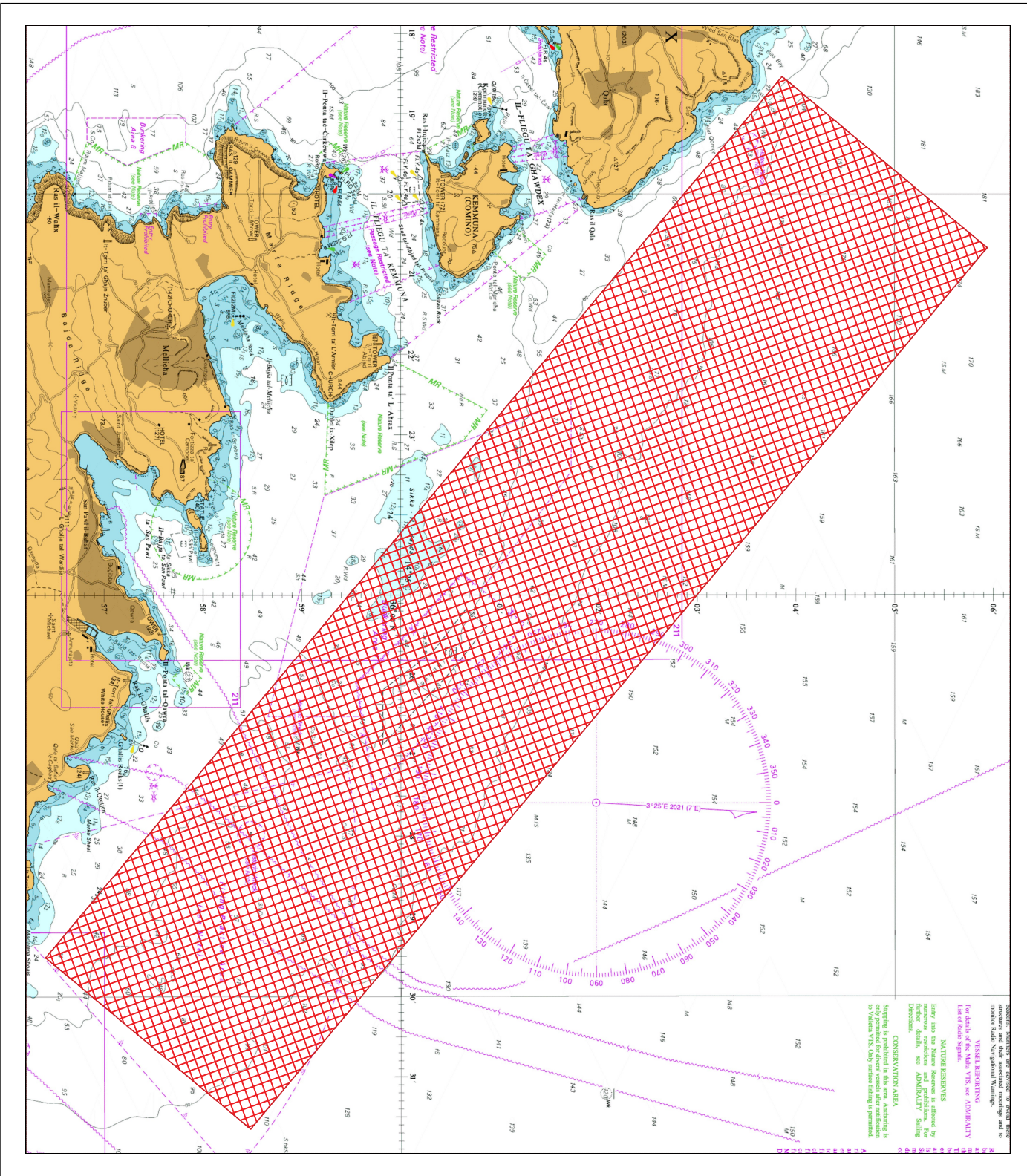
Weather permitting, the survey is scheduled to begin on Tuesday 7th April 2026 and is expected to be completed by Sunday 3rd May 2026.

The Rhodolith Survey will utilize a remotely operated Vehicle (ROV) to record seabed data in the area as shown in the attached chart.

During the surveys, the survey vessel SIMO (9HB6482) will be restricted in her ability to maneuver. Therefore, vessel masters operating in the vicinity are requested to keep a safe distance of at least 100m when it is spotted.

Masters and operators of vessels are advised to keep a sharp lookout, navigate with caution and at safe speed (no wake) when navigating in the above indicated area. They are to comply with instructions given on VHF Channel 12 and/or 16 by Valletta VTS, or by any enforcement agency on site.
