Diving next to the Main Breakwater arm at II-Port ta' Imgarr - Ghawdex

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies mariners and owners of vessels that diving operations will be taking place next to the Main Breakwater arm at II-Port tal-Mgarr - Għawdex.

The diving operations will take place on Wednesday 27th April 2022 between 1300 hours and 1500 hours, within the area bounded by the imaginary line A, B, C, D and the intermediate coastline, as shown on attached chart.

The diving team will be displaying the International Code of Signals flag "A" when diving operations are being carried out.

A safety zone of 25m around the survey area is to be observed throughout the allocated survey times. All vessel movements, transits, dockings and undockings outside the safety zone are to be coordinated with the diving team on site and with the port operations manager.

Masters and operators of vessels are advised to keep a sharp lookout, navigate with caution and at slow speed when proceeding close to the above indicated areas. They are to comply with instructions given on VHF Channel 10 and/or 16 by Mgarr Port Control and any Enforcement Personnel on site.
