Fireworks Display in St. Julian's Bay – Feast of St. Julian's - 2024

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies mariners that firework displays in connection with the feast of St Julian's will be let off from the breakwater (known as II-Pont tal-Banis) and from 6 pontoons moored in St Julian's Bay.

The firework displays will be let of from both the breakwater (known as il-Pont tal-Banis) point A and the 6 pontoons which will be moored along the imaginary line between points B and C, as shown on the attached chart.

The displays from both locations will take place on the following dates and times:

| Friday 23 rd August 2024 | from | 2245 hours till 2345 hours. |

| Saturday 24 th August 2024 | from | 2200 hours till 2300 hours. |
| Sunday 25 th August 2024 | | 1200 hours till 1300 hours and 2130 hours till 2230 hours. |

The pontoons will be moored in position 30 minutes before the display starts and will be removed within 30 minutes from the end of the display.

All vessels and bathers are warned to keep well clear and maintain a safe distance of not less than 60 metres from the breakwater (known as II-Pont tal-Banis) and 150m form the pontoons. Any vessels moored within indicated areas, as shown on the attached chart, are to be removed at least 1 hour before the start and stay away until 1 hour after the displays finish on the above-mentioned date and times.





Transport Malta will accept no liability whatsoever for any damage caused by the firework displays to any vessel and her ancillary equipment, whether such vessel and her ancillary equipment are left within the safety zones mentioned, or outside such safety zone, from the point from which the fireworks are let off.

Mariners shall comply with any instructions and directions given on VHF channel 12 and/or 16 by Valletta VTS and any Enforcement Officials in the area.
