## Fireworks Display - Feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel - Valletta

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies mariners that fireworks display in connection with the feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel will be let off from point A on Manoel Island (as shown on the attached chart) on the following date and times: -

Tuesday 15 <sup>th</sup> July 2025	from 1200 hours until 1230 hours,	
	from 1830 hours until 190	0 hours,
	from 2200 hours until 223	0 hours and
	from 2300 hours until 233	0 hours.
Wednesday 16 <sup>th</sup> July 2025	from 0800 hours until 083	0 hours,
	from 1200 hours until 1230 hours,	
	from 1900 hours until 193 from 2115 hours until 214	

Mariners are to keep a safe distance of at least 200 metres from the position indicated.

Any boats berthed or anchored within the area shown on the attached chart are to be removed during the above-mentioned dates and times.

Transport Malta will accept no liability whatsoever for any damage caused by the firework displays to any vessel and her ancillary equipment, whether such vessel and her ancillary equipment are left within the 200m safety zone, or outside such safety zone, from the point from which the fireworks are let off.

All mariners are to comply with any instructions given on VHF Channel 12 and/or 16, by Valletta VTS, while entering and navigating in Marsamxett Harbour.
