Under 18 Regatta races in Rinella Bay - 2023

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies Mariners that Under 18 regatta races will be held in Rinella Bay, Kalkara, the Grand Harbour.

The regatta races will be held on Saturday 8th July 2023 from 1500 hours to 1900 hours.

Four (4) buoys will be laid in positions A, B, C and D, as indicated on attached chart, to delineate the race area.

Any vessel which is within the designated area, which includes all Rinella Bay, must be removed by Saturday 8th July 2023 at 1300 hours.


The buoys will be laid on Saturday 8th July 2023 from 1300 hours. No vessel will be allowed to enter the designated area unless by special permission issued by Transport Malta. The buoys will be removed at the end of the races.

The positions of the buoys will be as follows:

	LATITUDE (N)	LONGITUDE (E)
A	35° 53'.845	14° 31'.355
B	35° 53'.656	14° 31'.614
C	35° 53'.612	14° 31'.565
D	35° 53'.800	14° 31'.306

All mariners are to comply with any instructions given on VHF Channel 12 and/or 16, by Valletta VTS and by any Enforcement Personnel on site.
