Fireworks Display - Feast of St. Joseph, Msida – 2026

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies mariners that Chinese Cakes/Stoppini and ground fireworks will be let off from point A and point B (as shown on the attached chart), on the following dates and times.

On Friday 17th July 2026 from midnight to 0030 hours on Saturday 18th July 2026.

On Saturday 18th July 2026 from 2245 hours to 2359hours.

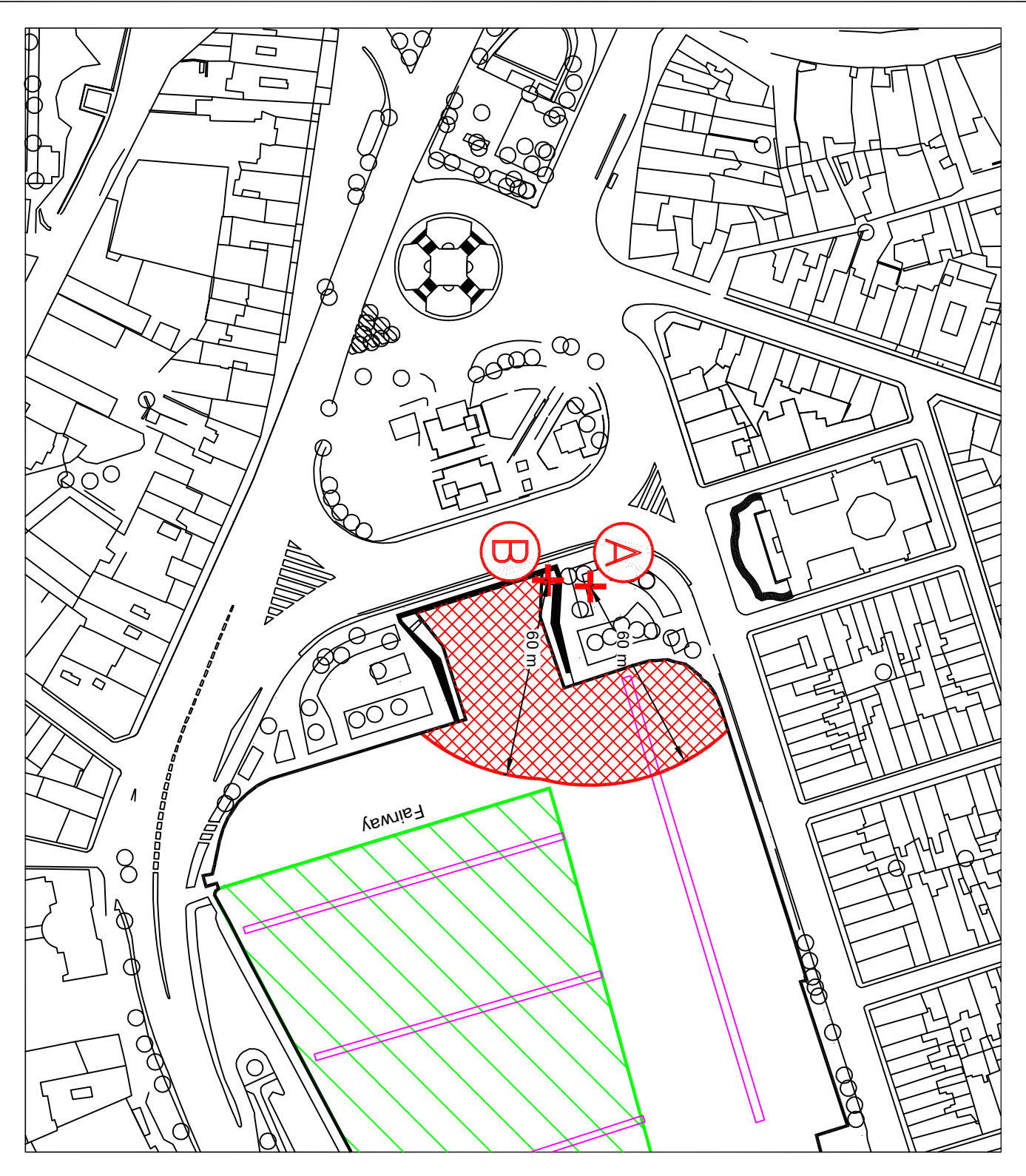
On Sunday 19th July 2026 from 2245 hours to 2315 hours.

Masters and owners of vessels that are berthed within the safety zones, the area shown in red on the attached chart, are to remove their vessels during the above-mentioned dates and times.
