Diving survey within the Grand Harbour - High Voltage Shore Connection Project

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies mariners and owners of vessels that a diving survey will be held within the Grand Harbour.

The diving survey will be held between Bridge Wharf and Fuel wharf within the area bounded by the imaginary lines joining the points A, B, C, D, the points E, F, G, H and the intermediate coastline as shown in red on the attached chart.

The diving survey will be carried out between Monday 25th July 2022 and Friday 29th July 2022.


The diving team will be assisted by the workboat “46” which will be displaying the International Code of Signals flag “A” when diving operations are being carried out.

A safety zone of 50m round the above-mentioned area is to be kept during the surveys.

Masters and operators of vessels are advised to keep a sharp lookout, proceed with caution and at slow speed when navigating in the vicinity of the above indicated area.

They are to cooperate with the contractor and comply with instructions given on VHF Channel 12 and/or 16 by Valletta VTS.
