Fireworks Display in St. Julian's Bay – Feast of St. Julian's - 2023

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, notifies mariners that firework displays in connection with the feast of St Julian's will be let off from the breakwater (known as Il-Pont tal-Banis) and from 6 pontoons moored in St Julian's Bay.

The firework displays will be let of from both the breakwater (known as il-Pont tal-Banis) point A and the 6 pontoons which will be moored along the imaginary line between points B and C, as shown on the attached chart.

POSITION	LATITUDE (N)	LONGITUDE (E)
A	35° 55'.123	014° 29'.575
B	35° 55'.075	014° 29'.721
C	35° 55'.043	014° 29'.710

The displays from point A will take place on the following dates and times:

Sunday 20th August 2023 from 2100 hours till 2115 hours.

Friday 25th August 2023 from 1200 hours till 1215 hours.

Saturday 26th August 2023 from 2200 hours till 2300 hours.

Sunday 27th August 2023 from 1200 hours till 1215 hours and
from 2200 hours till 2300 hours.

The displays from the pontoons between point B and point C will take place on the following dates and times:

Saturday 26th August 2023 from 2200 hours till 2300 hours.


The pontoons will be moored in position from 2130 hours and removed by 2330 hours.

All vessels and bathers are warned to keep well clear and maintain a safe distance of not less than 60 metres from the breakwater (known as Il-Pont tal-Banis) and 150m from the pontoons. Any vessels moored within indicated areas, as shown on the attached chart, are to be removed at least 1 hour before the start and stay away until 1 hour after the displays finish on the above-mentioned date and times.

Transport Malta will accept no liability whatsoever for any damage caused by the firework displays to any vessel and her ancillary equipment, whether such vessel and her ancillary equipment are left within the safety zones mentioned, or outside such safety zone, from the point from which the fireworks are let off.

Mariners shall comply with any instructions and directions given on VHF channel 12 and/or 16 by Valletta VTS and any Enforcement Officials in the area.
