## **Operation, Use and Navigation of Commercial Vessels**

The attention of all concerned is hereby being directed to the operation, use and navigation of commercial vessels within the internal and territorial waters of Malta in terms of the Commercial Vessels Regulations (S.L. 499.23). They are reminded that:

- i. Commercial vessels must be duly registered, certified and licensed and operated only by Masters and Crew in possession of the appropriate certificates of competency.
- ii. Due caution, diligence and courtesy must be exercised at all times by all persons operating, using and handling such vessels.

Such persons should practice good seamanship and observe all the applicable legislation in force and lawful directives of the Authority issued from time to time, in particular those concerning safe navigation and operation. A safe speed is to be always maintained.

- iii. Account should always be taken of the prevailing circumstances, taking into consideration the state of the wind, sea and current, the proximity of navigational hazards, and other users of the sea present in the area. Prescribed speed limitations are to be complied with.
- iv. One must ensure that the vessel being operated is fit for purpose; operated and used solely in accordance with its intended and certified use; manned in accordance with the minimum safe manning; and equipped with all the required safety equipment and apparatus. Such equipment and apparatus must be in a good working condition and not expired.
- v. A logbook must always be kept on board the vessel wherein all daily operations, movements and occurrences must be logged in detail.
- vi. In the event of any incidents or accidents, or an emergency situation, whether already taken place or still developing, an immediate verbal report must be made to the Authority on VHF Channel 12 / 14 or by phone on 2555 4490/91/92.

This verbal report must be followed by a written report within twenty-four (24) hours of the occurrence by using the Incident Report Form found in Annex A to this Notice. This Form can also be downloaded from the Authority's website (<u>www.transport.gov.mt</u>) under the tab 'Commercial Vessel Operations in Local Waters'. The applicable statutory provisions and any directions given by the Authority must be complied with.



In the event of any non-conformity or if transpires that dangerous navigation, use and operation is taking place which may endanger the safety of persons or the safety of navigation or could cause damage to property, enforcement and legal action in terms of law may be taken by the Authority.

Port Notice 03/2013 is hereby being revoked.
